Role & Responsibilities of INSPIRE Committee members

Head of Student Clubs & Student Affairs:

- Approves proposals for new student clubs and monitors their ongoing activities to ensure compliance with college guidelines.
- Ensures student clubs organize activities that are both engaging and appropriate, adhering to established guidelines.
- Acts as a point of contact for student concerns and issues, maintaining confidentiality and empathy. Conducts due diligence before escalating issues to higher authorities.

Head of Events & Marketing:
