

MINUTES OF MEETING

Date: 04-02-2026

Time: 10.00 AM to 11.30 AM

Venue: Principal Chamber

The meeting of the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) was held on 04-02-2026 at 10.00 AM in the Principal Chamber under the chairmanship of Dr. Ch. V. S. Parameswara Rao, Principal & Head of Institution. The council members discussed and finalized the action plan for Quarter-3 activities.

After detailed deliberations, the following resolutions were made:

1. Five-Day Boot Camp on Flagship Idea Exploration Program (23rd-27th February 2026)

It was resolved to organize a five-day intensive boot camp aimed at nurturing startup enthusiasts through structured mentoring, ideation workshops, design thinking sessions, business model development, and prototype validation. The program will focus on innovation, entrepreneurship development, and startup ecosystem exposure. Resource persons from industry and incubation centers will be invited to guide participants.

2. NCC Team Visit – Leadership & Discipline Orientation (25th February 2026)

The council approved the visit of the NCC team to conduct a **Leadership, Discipline, and Civic Responsibility Orientation Programme**. The session will emphasize personality development, structured training methodologies, national integration, and career opportunities in defence services. Interactive drills and motivational talks will be included to inspire students.

3. Visit of Officials from JD Institute of Fashion Technology (27th February 2026)

It was decided to facilitate an official visit by representatives from JD Institute of Fashion Technology to explore potential academic collaborations, interdisciplinary innovation opportunities, and knowledge-sharing initiatives. Discussions will focus on creative design integration, entrepreneurship avenues in fashion technology, and student exchange prospects.

4. National Science Day Celebration (28th February 2026)

The institution will commemorate National Science Day by organizing technical exhibitions, poster presentations, and awareness sessions to promote scientific temperament and innovation among students. Competitions and expert lectures will be conducted to highlight the importance of research and technological advancements.

5. Industrial Visit – Railway Signalling System (2nd March 2026)

An educational visit to a Railway Signalling facility will be arranged to provide students with practical exposure to signalling systems, safety protocols, automation technologies, and modern communication networks used in railway operations. The visit aims to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-time industrial practices.

6. Free Health Screening Camp (4th March 2026)

The council approved the organization of a Free Health Screening Camp for students and staff. The camp will include general medical check-ups, basic diagnostic tests, and health awareness counselling to promote preventive healthcare and well-being within the campus community.


7. Shesphere – Celebrating Womanhood (7th March 2026)
